THE FOLLOWING PRECAUTIONS SHALL BE TAKEN TO PREVENT FIRE BEFORE ANY WELDING OR CUTTING PERMIT IS APPROVED.

1. Welders' curtains established in the immediate area to protect other employees from arc.
2. Floors swept clean
3. Flammable and combustible materials removed from area. All remaining combustibles must be protected with metal guards or flame resistant covers (not ordinary tarpaulins).
4. All hazardous operations discontinued.
5. Fire watch provided to watch for dangerous sparks in area as well as floors above and below.
6. Adequate fire protection equipment provided extinguishers. (10 lb. ABC Extinguisher in site of welder or watch person).
7. Equipment being welded or cut has been thoroughly cleaned of all flammable material.

Authorization: The above-described location has been thoroughly inspected for fire hazards. The necessary precautions have been stipulated, and the employees understand the safety requirements. Permission is granted for this work.
